Purpose: Get to know parents' professions and their activities

Tasks:

Get to know and remember various professions of people;

To be interested and tell about the professions and jobs of their parents; If possible, visit parents' workplaces.;

Describe the activities of representatives of professions;

Develop respect for the representative of each profession and their work;

Enrich vocabulary, develop communication skills.

The first parents visited the "Širdukų" group and introduced the children to the profession of Farmer. Minte's mother, Goda, raises sheep. She introduced the children to the peculiarities of sheep breeding, showed them products made from sheep's wool. Goda's father Paulius grows grains - rye, wheat, peas, buckwheat. He told the children what is needed for the harvest to grow - sun, rain, warmth and love. The children learned that the healthiest thing to eat is black bread. Later, they examined the burnt grains and discussed which would grow faster.



Jovita, a teacher's assistant working in the group of students, has a profession as a seamstress. She told the children what was needed to sew a garment. The children got acquainted with fabrics, threads, cut-out drawings, and a sewing machine. Everyone was happy with the sewn sweater.



The “Hearts“ group was visited by Bernard’s mother Gintarė, who works at the Child Development Clinic as a medical psychologist. She told the children that they develop not only physically, but also emotionally and mentally. Children grow and their language, games, emotions, and communication change.



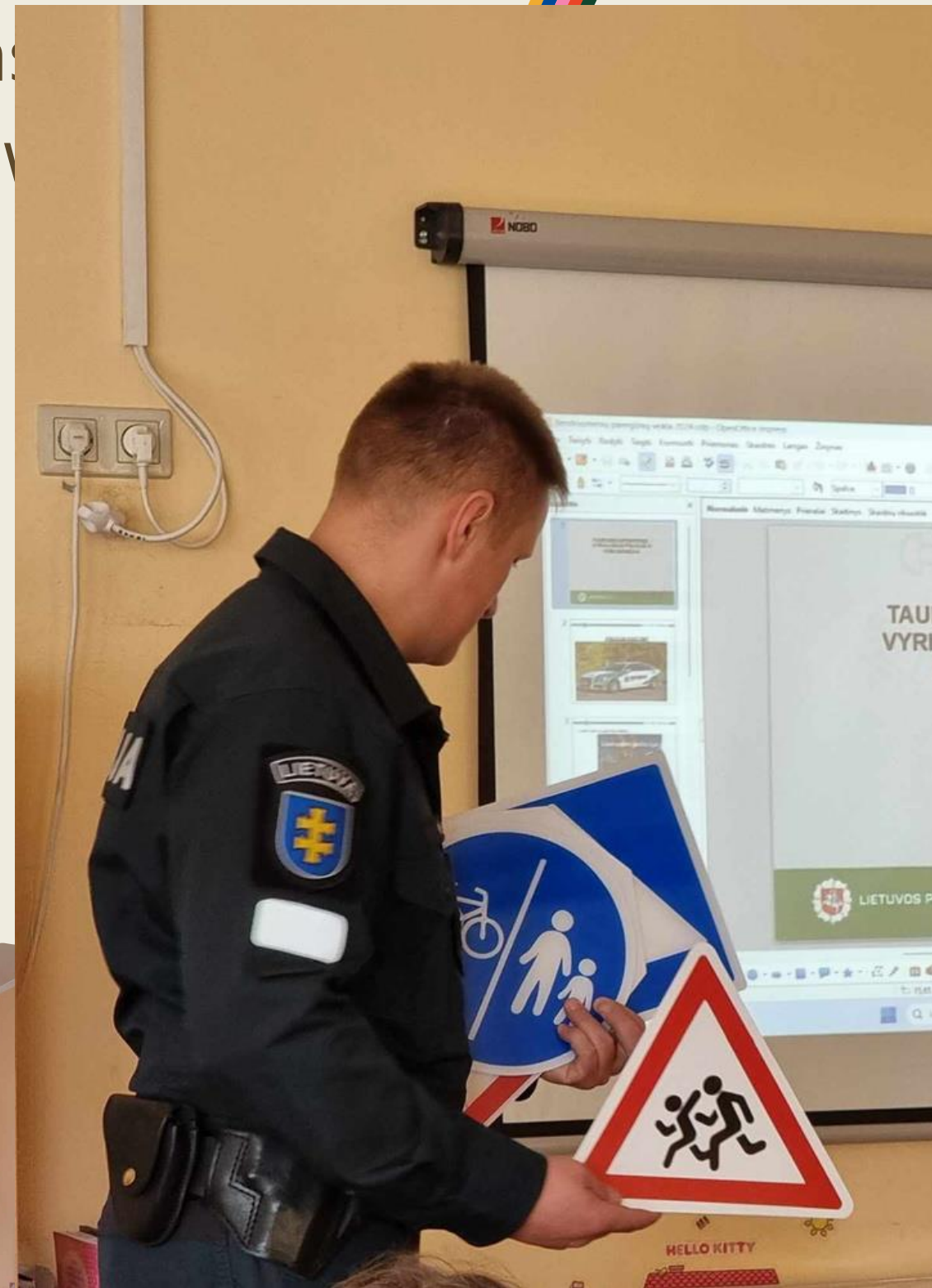
By city bus, the children of the "Pagrandukų" group went to the "Jysk" store, where Amanda's mother works. She showed the store, introduced the goods, took her to the warehouse. Children were allowed to choose goods and scan them, ride the elevator.



The children of the "Boružėlių" group traveled to the B. Baltrušaitytė public library of Tauragė district municipality. The little visitors not only got to know the profession of one of the students, Martina's mother, but also visited the departments in the library and learned about their activities. The children visited the local history, information, subscription, art and music departments, the periodical reading room, and the computer class. The "Ladies" were especially fascinated by the centuries-old books in the storage, and the whole excursion was crowned by a musical session.



Elija's father, Raimundas, who is a police officer, visited the "Pagrandukų" group. The children learned what the motto DEFEND, PROTECT, HELP means, what got acquainted with police equipment and tools. Everyone was excited and they are going to be policemen when they grow up!



The children of the "Varpelia" group traveled to the fire service of the Tauragė district municipality, where they got to know the profession of Rusnė's father. Employees of the fire service explained how fires start, showed extinguishing equipment, children had the opportunity to sit in a fire engine. Thank you to Rusnė's father and all the employees for the warm welcome and interesting story about the hard work of a firefighter.



"Saulučiu" gr. the children traveled to the Tauragė sports center, where they got to know the profession of Dominykas' father, a basketball coach. He talked about how he teaches kids to play basketball, how to work together as a team and how to behave honorably in winning and losing games.



Odrė's mother Agnė, who works as a general practice nurse in the blood test room - laboratory, was a guest of the "Boružėlių" group. The children got acquainted with the specifics of her work, saw a video about the blood test laboratory, learned why blood tests are important and with what tools they are performed. Mummy encouraged everyone to overcome their fear and bravely come for the blood test. And traditionally, at the end of the procedure, mommy fed all the children with healthy sweets of her own production.



Radvilė's father, Renaldas, who works in the advertising agency "REKLAMUOKIS", was a guest of the "Saulučiu" group. The children got to know the specifics of his work, saw a video of how advertisements are made, learned why he makes them and where they can be seen. The children themselves created advertising for their store. ✨ ✨



The "Smalsučiu" group was visited by Gabija's mother, who introduced her to the seamstress profession. The children got to know the basic sewing tools, watching a dress being sewn for a doll, learned the history of the appearance of clothes, why different colored threads are needed and how to store needles safely. He taught himself how to insert a thread, measure the length of a sleeve, and sew with a sewing machine. Mommy decorated the group's dolls with new clothes. ✨ ✨ ✨



"Aitvaru" gr. Leia's father, who works as a soldier in the artillery battalion of General Motiejus Petiulionis' brigade, was visiting. The children got to know the profession of a soldier, found out what the soldiers' agenda is, tried on the equipment.



"Boružėlii" gr. children spent time in the yard of the kindergarten - in the "House on wheels". Martina's parents, Kristina and Marius, told about the family's additional activity - the rental of the mobile home "Ratuoti namai". The children were interestingly introduced to the basics of entrepreneurship and financial literacy. According to Martina's parents, their family encourages other families to spend their free time with quality and content. Most of the cabins are rented by families with children, and Martina and her sister always ask what age the children will be traveling and based on that, the sisters prepare a box of toys for the children, for which the customers leave a tip for the girls. "Boružėlii" gr. it was very interesting for the children to see what the house looks like during the day, and then how it is transformed into a bedroom. Everyone "tried on" all the beds, played games with girls' toys, and feasted.



Mommy Ažuolas told the children of the "PYKŠT" group about the profession of a medical worker (nurse). He showed his work tools, taught how to bandage an injured body part, measure blood pressure, pulse, and use a catheter. The children listened with interest and received gifts after answering the questions.



"Aitvaru" gr. the children traveled to Norfa's pharmacy, where they got to know the profession of Luka's mother, a pharmacist. She showed the pharmacy, explained what medicines are available, what they are for and why children cannot take them without adult permission.



Teacher's assistant Sandra, "Širdukų" gr. introduced the children to her second profession - hairdresser. The children saw an abundance of tools, thanks to which it is possible to make a beautiful haircut or make a hairstyle. Sandra mentioned that the profession of a hairdresser is one of the happiest, because when you do a beautiful haircut, make a hairstyle and see someone smiling, you yourself are charged with positive emotions.



The children of the "Nykštukų" and "Širdukų" groups took part in the Nordic walking class, which was led by Lukutis' father - an employee of the Tauragė public health office - coach Marius Trajanauskas. At the beginning of the session, everyone did a warm-up exercise together, after which the coach taught them how to hold the sticks correctly, the children went around the kindergarten.


